Taylor Rd. is a left turn just before and adjacent to the Railroad.

Proceed approx 1/2 mile to park entrance.

BHA DRIVING RULES AND GUIDELINES

Awards: Trophy and 6 ribbons awarded in all classes

Horse/Pony listed as combined division - will be split if there are 4 or more entries of each

HORSE - SINGLE OR MULTIPLE

Driver of any age may compete

Any Single or Multiple of Horse/s/Mule/s over 14.2 hands

PONY - SINGLE OR MULTIPLE

Driver of any age may compete

Any Single or Multiple of pony/s/mule/s

14.2 hands or under

NOVICE DRIVER:

Driver of any age may compete

Any Equine shown in suitable harness

May not have received more than 3 blue ribbons in any driving show prior to the current season

If entries warrant, classes will be split based on size of equine

VSE - SINGLE OR MULTIPLE

Driver of any age may compete

Any Single or Multiple of equine

40 inches or under shown in suitable harness

Wire Wheel Vehicles allowed in Novice Division

Any Driver/Passenger under 18 must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet

Jr. Drivers Must have an adult in the cart at all times
