Pre-entries close Aug, 20

Event will be held Rain or Shine. First ride on outside trail course to begin at 9:00

Pre-entries will receive their ride time by phone and/or email

Entry Fees: Pre-entry before closing date - \$20. Post Entries day of event – \$25

Plus a grounds fee of \$8 per horse/rider combination

Challenge fee to include 1)Outside trail course of 8 to 10 obstacles, 2)Ring course of obstacles of the type normally seen in horse shows, and 3) "Pleasure Class" in the main ring .

DIVISIONS

Junior Advanced – For horses & riders with trail experience (17 or under on 11/1/2018)

Senior Advanced – For horses & riders with trail experience (18 or over on 11/1/2018)

Beginner – For riders of any age with less trail experience. Pleasure class walk/trot/jog

Green Horse – For horses with less experience on the trail. Pleasure class walk/trot/jog

Awards: 6 Ribbons per Division, plus placing ribbons for Pleasure Class

*******ALL DIVISIONS OPEN TO BOTH ENGLISH AND WESTERN RIDERS*******

MUST ENTER BOTH JUNE & AUGUST EVENTS TO QUALIFY FOR YEAR END AWARD

Trail Course: Can be ridden in groups of 2 or 3. Each rider will be judged separately – no assistance allowed.

Group may be of mixed divisions. Obstacles of the type that may be encountered when trail riding.

Ring Course: Riders will go individually

Pleasure Class: to be held in the main ring. Each division will ride as a group class.

DIVISIONS:

JR/SR ADVANCED: Experienced trail horses and riders. Obstacles may be more challenging on the trail, and more technical for the ring class. Ring class and Pleasure Class will be walk/jog or trot/lope or canter

BEGINNER: For individuals in their first years of riding and/or just starting to trail ride and work on obstacles. Obstacles may be less challenging than for the advanced group. The ring course will be shorter or less technical. The Pleasure Class will be walk/trot/or jog. **Beginner riders must go out on the trail with an advanced rider or ground person.**

GREEN HORSE: Open to experienced riders with a horse in its first years under saddle or just starting on trails or obstacles. Obstacles may be less challenging than the advanced group. The ring trail course may be shorter and less technical. Pleasure class will be walk/trot/jog. It is recommended that Green Horses go on the trail course with an advanced rider.

ASTM/FEI HELMETS REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS – NO EXCEPTIONS
